
1. What is "Tosa-no-Okyaku" ("Kochi-style Party")?




You can get to Kochi by plane in one and a half hours from Tokyo, or two and a half hours from Taipei.

5. The Economic Impact of "Tosa-no-Okyaku" and its Future Challenges

Economic Impact

- Since its start in 2006, the number of visitors has increased almost every year. In 2024, after the COVID-19 pandemic, the number of visitors exceeded 90,000, which was a record high. In 2025, it may even surpass 100,000.
- The average spending per visitor has also generally increased, and the economic ripple effect exceeded
 1 billion yen in 2024, significantly contributing to regional revitalization.

Future Challenges

- Attracting visitors from outside the prefecture: Out of 90,000 visitors, only about 8,000 are from outside the prefecture, meaning around 90% are local visitors.
- Attracting foreign tourists/Increasing inbound tourism
- Improving cashless payment options: Creating a system that is easy for tourists to use.
- Promoting the development and sale of related merchandise.
